Quetzalcoatl "Crucified"

A vivid early 19th-century original watercolor by Captain William H. Shippard with images after two well-known Aztec codices. The top half of the sheet shows a dramatic scene from the Codex Vaticanus, while the lower half has a somewhat controversial image of Quetzalcoatl from the Codex Borgia. While earlier writers, including Shippard himself, have described this second image as "Quetzalcoatl crucified," recent scholars have come to a more nuanced understanding of this intriguing pictogram, styling it as part of a ritual sequence involving the participation of Quetzalcoatl, following a long supernatural journey.



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Detailed Condition:
