Description:

Rare miniature map of the Southern Colonies, extending to the confluence of the Ohio and Mississippi Rivers and Lake Louisiana. The borders of Georgia and each of the Carolinas extend to the Mississippi. The map appeared in John Gibson's Atlas Minimus, one of the earliest miniature English Atlases to include a number or regional maps of the Colonies. The map provides interesting coastal details and also names a number of forts settlements and forts in the interior of Georgia, including Augusta, Ft. Toulouze, Ft. Mobile and Corvetas. Notes on both colonies in the text offshore. A terrific American Miniature, which rarely appears on the market. This is one of the few works to include regional maps of the American Colonies at the time of the French & Indian War. The map has ben trimmed just outside the neatline and laid on a larger sheet.
