

#### Description:

Nice original vintage navigational chart for San Juan, Puerto Rico, first published by the British Admiralty in 1903 and updated to 1931.

San Juan is still a very small town, limited to the walled city of Viejo San Juan. Small settlements can be seen in Puerto de Tierra and Cataño Pueblo. The many infill projects in the bay have not yet been undertaken, with the bathymetry and geography of the bay vastly different than they stand today.

The data on the map is taken from United States government charts published between 1899 and 1925. Navigational detail on the map is very extensive, with soundings, lighthouses, and anchorages all shown, and magnetic deviation indicated.

#### Detailed Condition:

Original coloring of the lighthouses and buoys. Nice, clean example. Chartseller's purple stamp reading "Increase 50%."
