The Rarest Atlas Map of Virginia

Extremely rare map of Virginia, published Tanner's *New General Atlas*, published in New York City by Tanner's Geographical Establishment, written and engraved by Joseph Perkins.

Pre-dates the separation of West Virginia from Virginia and many of the counties in the northwestern Virginia.

Tanner's *New General Atlas* was issued following Tanner's sale of his *Universal Atlas* to Samuel August Mitchell. The *Universal Atlas*, which had been published in Philadelphia from 1836 to 1845. Tanner's New General Atlas, for which Anthony Finley was also a collaborator, is one of the rarest 19th Century American atlases.
