Description:

Fantastic antique map of Central Europe, focused on Germany and showing the whole of the Netherlands, Czechoslovakia, and Austria, as well as parts of Northern Italy, Denmark, France, and Belgium. The map was made by Nicholas Sanson and published in Paris in 1658 by Pierre Mariette, an important 17th-century French cartographer. The title cartouche also credits Melchior Tavernier as a (seemingly earlier) publisher of the map.

Detail on the map is extensive, with a number of cities, rivers, and other geographical features shown. The map is colored and demarcated according to regions, which are also named.

Detailed Condition:

Engraving on 17th-century laid paper. Original hand-color in outline. Very minor toning at blank border edges, not affecting map image.
