Two title banners include a short sketch of the history of the Dutch on the island, *Remarques sur l'Etablissement des Hollandois à Java*, written by Gueudeville. The latter provided historical notes for the countries depicted on the maps. At the left and right outer margin, there is a list of cities, Table des Villes de l'Ile de Java. The map graphically depicts rice fields, mountains, forests, cities, villages and even elephants.
