Detailed map of the North Rhine-Westphalia region of Germany.

Centered on the Maas and Rhine Rivers. Dusseldorf is at the top right corner and Cologne and Bonn are toward the bottom right, with the Maas River and the Dutch border to the left.

The present map was produced by two of the primary Cologne School mapmakers, Johann Bussemacher and Matthias Quad. The Cologne School of cartography, was perhaps the only group of mapmakers competing with the Low Countries-based map publishing houses at the end of the 16th century (De Jode and Ortelius).
