Description:

Nice example of De Jode's map of "Hannoniae" (Hainaut), from his *Speculum Orbis Terrarum*, which is, after Ortelius's *Theatrum Orbis Terrarum*, the second-earliest modern atlases of the World.

The map covers a region in southern Belgium, with detail extending into France. The map includes Tournai, Ath, Mons, Charleroi, and Dinant, along with a number of other city names. The illustration of the Ardenne Woods (Ardenna Silva) in the southeast, is interesting.

This example originally appeared in the 1593 second and final edition of the *Speculum*.

Detailed Condition:

Dampstaining in lower left and right. Several areas of repaired loss, including in the lower left and right, and along centerfold.
