

Wonderfully detailed map of the region from Lake Timpanogos, Lake Teguayo and Rio de los Piramides Sulfareas in the West and extending into modern day Colorado and Wyoming, showing more detail than any other contemporary map.

Gorgeous old color, which is very unusual for this map. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale. His treatment of the Western US is a landmark in the history of cartography of the Western US, undertaking to map in 20 sheets a region which American publishers were virtually ignoring.
