Fine original color example of Herman Moll's large map of Scotland, flanked by city views on either side of the map.

Moll was famously political in his maps, with characteristic hubris for other nations. On this map, Moll marks the fishing grounds and states 'if things were rightly managed, there would be no reason to go to Norway for wood or New-found-land for fish; seeing North Britain can Plentifully furnish us with both'.

Detailed Condition:

Engraving on two sheets of 18th-century laid paper joined as one. Original hand-color in outline. Minor toning to the two vertical folds.
