

## **Description:**

Scarce map of Russian America, being perhaps the first separate map of the region which would become Alaska.

The region extends south to Queen Charlotte's Island and includes some modest detail in the interior Mountains. The map is a fascinating look at the region, shortly after Vancouver and La Perouse. Much of the coastline above the Bering Straits is still unexplored. While similar to maps issued by Carey & Lea, this map is unique to Buchon's French edition of the Carey & Lea, making this map unique.
