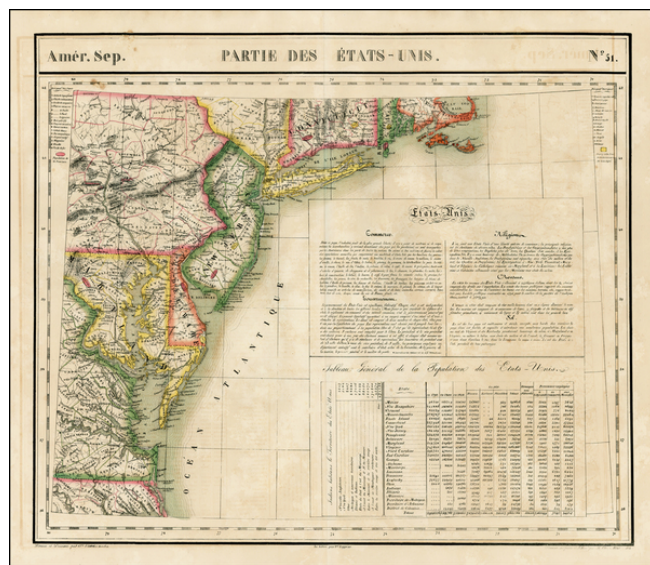

The map is a testament to the phenomenal effort Vandermaelen undertook to compile contemporary and highly detailed information from all parts of the world. This map shows the region from just south of the Chesapeake to Long Island and Cape Cod. Includes Counties, towns, rivers, roads, mountains, rivers, islands, etc. A remarkable map of the eastern US, with extensive notes on commerce, religion, government, revenues and weather and a large state by state population table, showing growth by decade for 1790, 1800, 1810 and then substantial detail for 1820, including populations for whites, slaves and free blacks, as well as populations of non-citizens, and information on the employment, broken down by agriculture, commerce and manufacturing.
