### Description:

Scarce separately issued map Southeastern Virginia, produced by Lindenköhl and lithographed by Krebs at the direction of the US War Department in 1864.

The map depicts the towns, courthouses, lines of communication and other militarily significant information in fine detail and includes a list of 10 maps (some being groups of maps) utilized by Lindenköhl in preparing this map. Second edition, revised to include military campaign maps from 1864.

During the Civil War, the US Coast Survey Department became the official mapmaking branch of the United States War Department. Under the direction of A.D. Bache, many of the most talented surveyors and mapmakers were employed compiling maps from existing official and commercial sources. Among the most active were the Lindenköhl brothers, whose names appear on a number of these maps.

### Detailed Condition:

Flattened and archivally backed with a thin sheet of Japan paper to support an old tear. Never folded!
