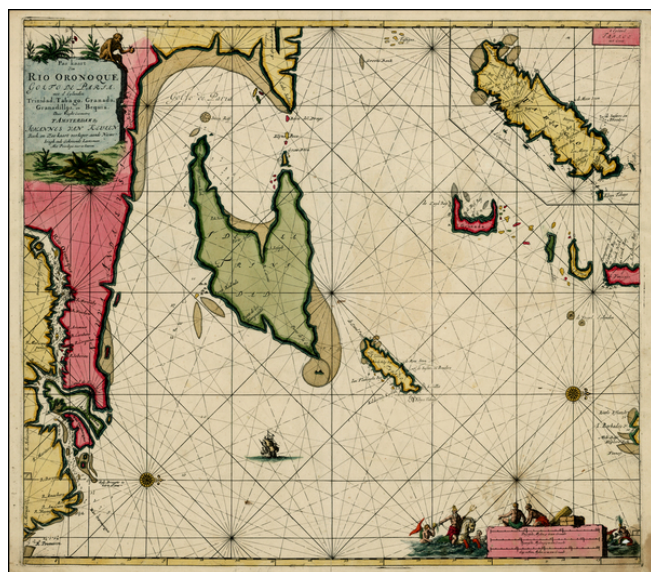

Description:

Fine example of Van Keulen's sea chart of the mouth of the Orinoco River, Trinidad, Tabago and neighboring islands, from *De Nieuwe Groote Lichtende Zee-Fakkell*, Part IV.

Striking chart of the Gulf of Paria covering the region from the entrance to the Orinoco River to the islands from Trinidad to St. Vincent. The chart is oriented with north to the right by two compass roses. A large inset shows Tobago on a larger scale. Decorative scale cartouche features Neptune with his entourage and natives with trade goods. The map is further adorned with a monkey atop the title cartouche and a sailing ship.

Includes towns, anchorages, soundings, ports, etc. The Van Keulen family dominated the chart making business in Holland from the 1680s until the middle of the 19th Century.
