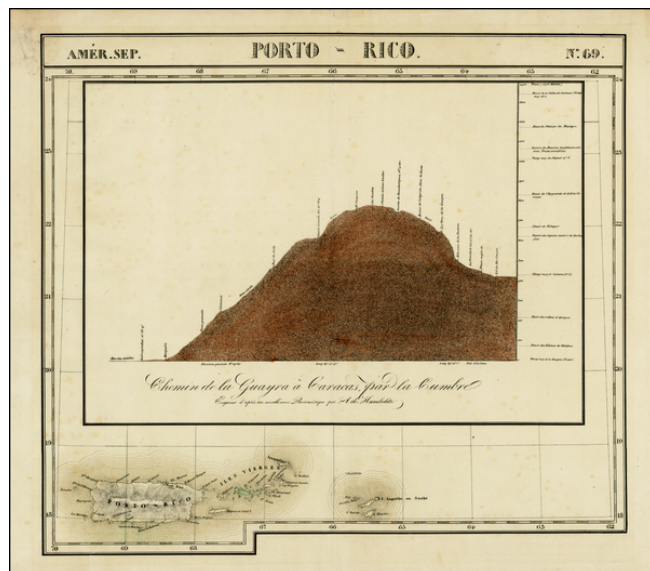

Interesting regional map, showing Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, St. Martins and Anguille.

The coverage of the Virgin Islands includes St. Thomas, St. John, Virgin Gorda, Tortola, Anegadia and the other primary islands, other than St. Croix. Nice detail in Puerto Rico, including approximately 20 place names. The map includes a large profile of the topography, from Alexandre Von Humboldt's seminal work in America in the early 1800s. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
