Excellent detail in the Caribbean. Texas area shows site where Here Mr. La Salle settled in 1685 and Here Mr. LaSalle was Murdered in 1687. Eight placenames in Texas. Numerous cliffs and forts are named on the lower Mississippi River such as Davion's Rocks or Loftusis's Cliffs.
