The map shows the region bounded by the Baltic, the Oder, the Bug and the Vistula and extending south to Krackow, east to Brierstie Litepski, north to Konigsberg and west to Stetin, Glogau and Breslau.

The two unique features of this map are the dozens of heraldic crests which adorn the map and the many roads shown on the map, which was very uncommon during the 17th Century.
