Fine example of the first state of Finley's early map of Texas, Upper California, New Mexico and Mexico proper, from Finley's *General Atlas*, showing Upper California (New Albion and New California), and showing the Spanish Intendencies of San Luis Potosi, New Mexico, Durango and Sonora, among others. Wonderful detail.

Includes the mythical lakes of Timanagos and Teguayo on the River Buenaventura which reached from SF Bay to Salt Lake.

The Carnacaways Indians are shown in Texas, as is St. Antonio and St. Jose, along with Galveston, Loredon, Mier and other early place names. Many Indian names included.
