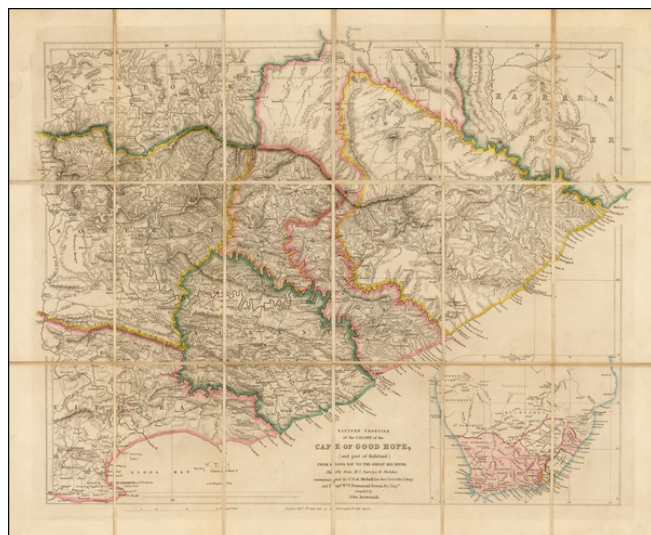

Fine separately issued map of part of the Colony of the Cape of Good Hope, published by John Arrowsmith in London.

Fine example of John Arrowsmith's meticulous style and remains one of the finest nineteenth century maps of the area.

The map provides a remarkable early look at the settlements along South Africa's eastern coast, stretching from Port Elizabeth to the mouth of the Great Kei River. In the lower right corner is an inset map of the whole country, showing the county divisions and the principal towns. There are a wealth of topographical detail as well as geographical comments and tribe locations.

The map provides a remarkable look at the evolution of the settlement and cartographic knowledge of the region, a fine juxtaposition to the information depicted in Arrowsmith's map of the same region from 1836.
