Bayard Taylor was a travel writer. Bayard wrote a popular account of the California Gold Rush, entitled *A Voyage to California...Life in San Francisco and Monterey; pictures of the gold region...* This included some charming tinted lithographs based on his own first-hand drawings. These are rare early mages of California at this exciting time.
