

One of the first maps of the state of New Hampshire published outside of America.

Size includes text surrounding map, which includes wonderful contemporary details concerning the topography, indigenous lands, rivers, climate, towns, manufacturing, commerce, education, history, population by county, and other information.

Key notes flag for five remarkable battles. Carey & Lea's Atlas is highly prized not only for its cartographic information but the marvelous information about each of the states and territories included. The atlas was issued in 6 editions in English, French & German between 1822 and 1827.

The French edition is generally the most highly regarded, in terms of the quality of the paper and engraving.
