Scarce early map of Florida, published one year before it was admitted to the Union.

This is the second edition of the map, which was first issued in 1845.

Shows early roads, towns, rivers, lakes, islands and other features. Mosquito County extends from Lake George to Lake Macacao and only Monroe, Hillsboro and Dade Counties are shown in the southern 2/3rds of the state, with Dade appearing far northwest of its current position.

Includes plans of Pensacola, Tallahassee and the Harbor at St. Augustine. Includes distance tables between a number of major and minor cities.

From one of the leading German map makers of the period.
