

The map is drawn largely from the 1795 Matthew Carey map of New Hampshire by Samuel Lewis. An excellent topographical map, showing the counties, boundaries, principal towns, mountains, rivers, islands and many other details.

John Reid's American Atlas was the second folio sized atlas published in the US. Reid's atlas was originally
