

The chart includes a pronunciation guide at right, and a key to important lettered points at left. The imprint at bottom credits D. Lerpeniere with the etching and B. Henry with the engraved portions of the chart.

Alexander Dalrymple was a Scottish hydrographer who explored the Philippines in the employ of the East India Company.
