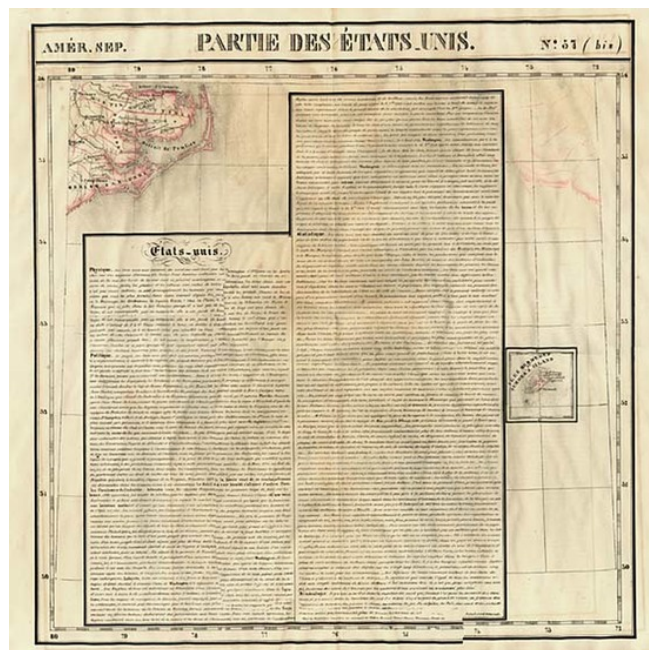

Description:

Interesting map of a part of North Carolina, including Albermarle and Pamlico Sounds, and Martin, Washington, Pitt, Curritore, Beaufort, Tyrrel and Hyde Counties. Shows Newberne, Jamestown, Tarboro, Greenville, Kingston, Washington and other towns. Bermuda is shown in a small inset. Includes a lengthy discussion of the US. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale. His treatment of the Western US is a landmark in the history of the cartography of the Western US, undertaking to map in 20 sheets a region which American publishers were virtually ignoring. A fine unfolded and probably separately issued example of this pair of maps covering the Baja. A bit of color offsetting, but a nice example of this relatively scarce map, for which only a few hundred were ever printed.
