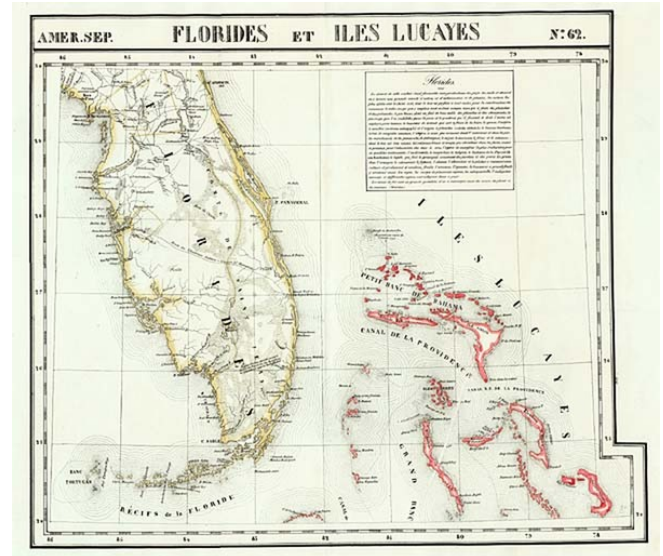

Description:

Scarce map of Florida and the Bahamas, exhibiting tremendous detail for the period, including Roads in Florida, the Indian Trail which traverses the peninsula, annotations on the Everglades and many place names. Several early colonies are noted. Excellent detail in the keys. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale. His treatment of the Western US is a landmark in the history of the cartography of the Western US, undertaking to map in 20 sheets a region which American publishers were virtually ignoring.
