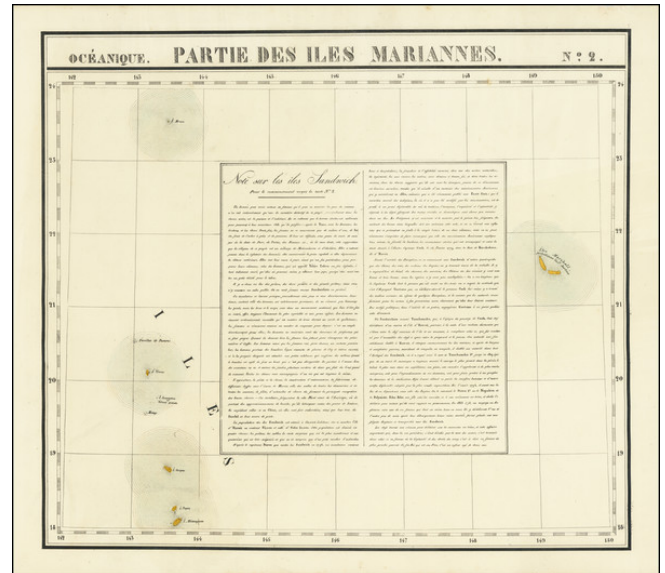

Description:

Interesting antique hand-colored lithographed map of the Marshall Islands, with a detailed description of Hawaii ("Note sur les iles Sandwich").

The map shows two "Iles Marshall" and speculates that they are probably the Jardine islands. The islands were named after Captain Marshall of the First Fleet ship *Scarborough*.

A nice example of this early and highly detailed regional map. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6-volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
