

Description:

Fine old color example of Homann's decorative and highly detailed plan of Strasbourg, with a striking view of the City below.

At the time, Strasbourg was under French rule following Louis XIV's 1681 annexation, in which it would remain until Germany's 1871 victory in the Franco-Prussian War, before being claimed again by France.

Fort Kehl, on the right, was the site of a French victory over Austrian troops in the 1733 Siege of Kehl in the War of the Polish Succession.

A fine dark impression.
