Highly detailed set of maps illustrating the British Colonies in North America at the conclusion of the American Revolution, published by Soules in his *Histoire des Troubles de Amerique Anglaise*.

The primary map shows the British Colonies in North America, extending just beyond the Appalachian Mountains, as well as the Great Lakes and Canada.

The large inset map provides an excellent treatment of the Mississippi Valley and Tributaries, extending north to Lake Superior and centered on the confluence of the Mississippi River and the Missouri River. A smaller inset shows most of what was then Georgia and Western Florida, with a smaller inset of Niagara Falls.
