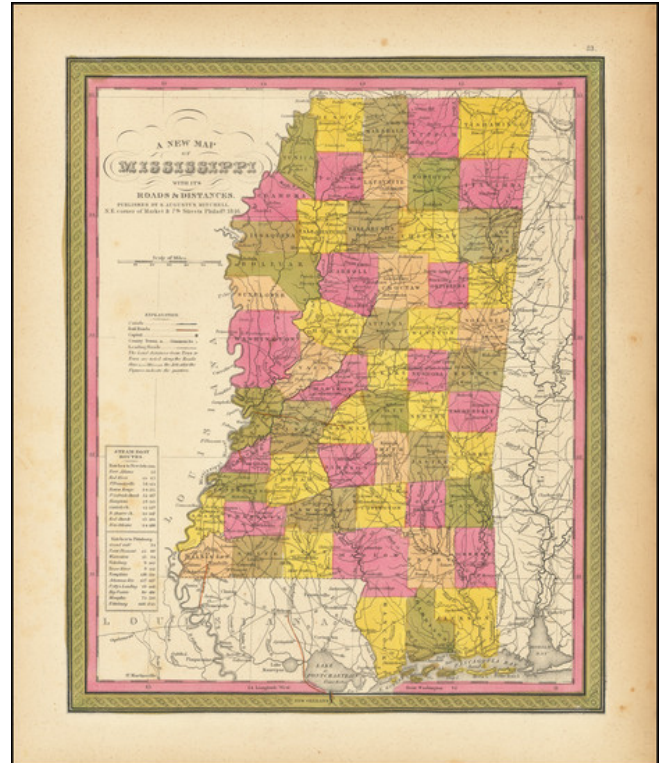

Description:

Detailed and interesting map of Mississippi, published by Samuel Augustus Mitchell.

The map is hand colored, showing towns, rivers, bays, lakes, railroads, roads, distances, etc. Notable depictions include the Mississippi and Red Rivers and all the counties of the state, named and colored. The roads and canals are differentiated by color which appears to be hand drawn in.

Includes tables of steamboat routes and distances. Calculates distances from various cities in Mississippi and nearby regions based on their distance from New Orleans or Pittsburg. Also gives distances between the chosen starting location (Natchez) and other areas on the table.

Mitchell's pre-1850 maps are becoming increasingly rare and difficult to obtain.
