**Description:**

Nice example of this finely engraved map of western part of Sub-Saharan Africa, first published by Nicholas Sanson in Paris in 1654.

Of note is the title, which includes the words Pays de Negres (Country of the Negroes).

Sanson was the Royal Geographer to the King of France and perhaps the most important commercial mapmaker of his generation.

Originally published by Sanson, the map was re-issued by Zurner in 1679 in Frankfurt and by Ribbuis in 1683 in Utrecht.
