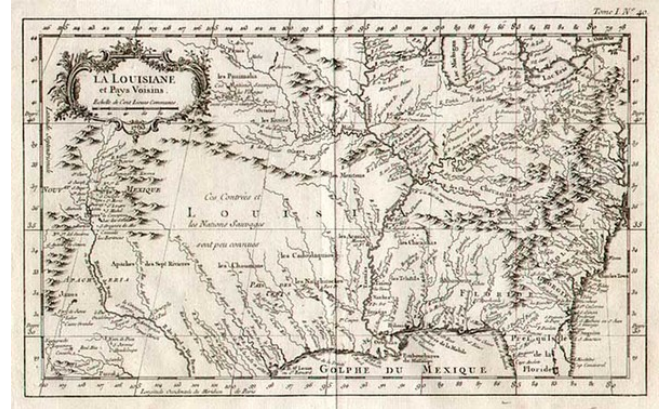

Description:

Bellin's map of Louisiana from the Petit Atlas Maritime. The map should not be confused with the much more common Carte de La Louisiane et Pays Voisons issued in the Histoire Generale de Voyages 1757. This later edition is much scarcer, extends further west and by far the better engraved and more desirable of the two. A side by side comparison will make this obvious. Wide margins and heavy paper, again unlike the early edition. Meticulous detail along the Mississippi Valley, including early French Forts, Indian Tribes and Villages and early exploration features. The detail in Texas and along the Missouri River is also noteworthy. Issued shortly after the French and Indian War was concluded. Phillips p370.
