Joris van Spilbergen (1568 - 1620) was a Dutch naval officer of the 17th century.

In 1614, he sailed beyond the Straits of Magellan and raided the Spanish settlements of the coast of California. From 1578, El Quisco together with the neighbor Algarrobo and El Canelo were a hiding place of pirates such as the Englishmen Francis Drake, Thomas Cavendish, Richard Hawkins and the Dutchmen Oliver Van Noort and Joris van Spilbergen. He had some fights with Sebastian Vizcaino and Nicolas de Cardona. He circumnavigated the earth, and returned to Holland in 1617.
