The map is largely based upon the explorations of Humboldt and Long in the Rocky Mountains and the West. It includes extensive notes along the lower Missouri and Lower Mississippi Rivers and remarkable detail in the Southern Rocky Mountain Regions. There are two Salt Lake's and a mysterious river connecting them. Nice detail in Arizona and along the Colorado River and a nice early projection of Baja California. Pike's explorations in the region are also in evidence. An essential map for Southwestern, Trans-Mississippi West and Texas collectors.
