Description:

Striking example of Hondius' map of Chil, with 3 cartouches, sea monsters, sailing ships and 2 ornate compass roses. Extends north to Mutantor and Puerto de Vetus and the R. de Copayapo and locates at least 50 places, including Santiago de la Nueva Estremadura (Santiago), Baldivia, Osorno, Imperial, Ongol villa nueva de los Infantes, La Concepcion and L Serena. The Andes are shown prominently, with an unnamed lake and Mendoza and San Juan de la Frontera as the only plces named on the east side of the Lake. A striking dark impression of this early decorative map from an early French edition of Hondius Atlante Appendix.
