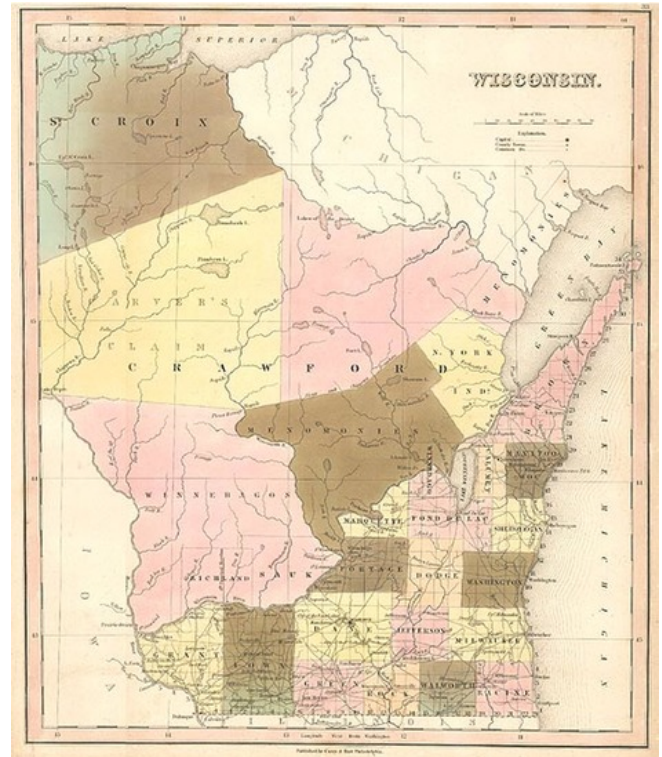

Description:

Gorgeous example of this early map of Wisconsin, issued only 6 years after it first became a territory. The lands south of the Wisconsin and Fox Rivers are largely surveyed and many early counties, towns, etc. appear. The region to the north is dominated by the lands of the Winnebago, Menomonie, New York (Oneida) Indians and the Sioux and Chippewa Boundary to the North. Massive Carver claim remains, now nearly 100 years old. The south is filled with roads, and towns, the north rivers, portages, etc. One of the best early maps of Wisconsin in full original color. A nice example of Tanner's map, which rarely appears on the market. An essential map for Wisconsin collectors.
