The map provides interesting coastal details and also names a number of forts settlements and forts in the interior of Georgia, including Augusta, Ft. Toulouze, Ft. Mobile and Corvetas. Notes on both colonies in the text offshore. A terrific American Miniature, which rarely appears on the market. This is one of the few works to include regional maps of the colonies at the time of the French & Indian War.
