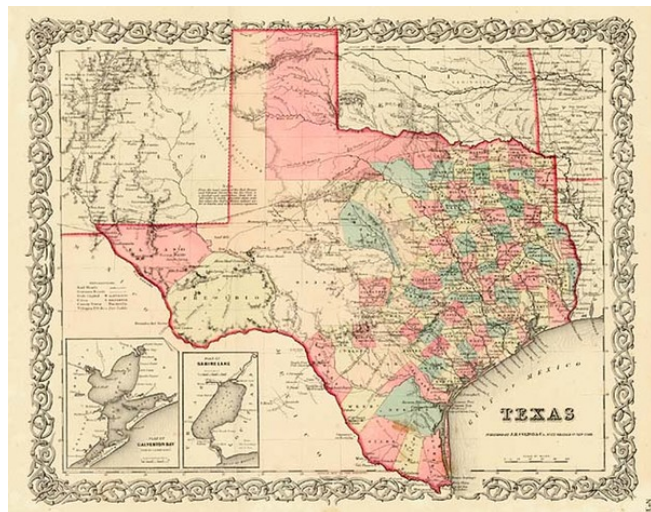

Early detailed map of Texas, from the 1855 edition of Colton's General Atlas, the only edition to appear in a single page format. The map shows a very incomplete set of Western Texas Counties. The German Settlements in Gillespie County are still shown. Includes roads, towns, counties, Indian Trails, Connelly's Trail, Proposed Pacific RR Route, Smith & Whitney's Route, the Route to Ft. Smith, Loredo Road, Upper Presidio Road, Lower Presidio Road, etc. Many forts and other places of interest are shown. Large insets of Sabine Lake and Galveston area. A nice example, with a bit of foxing, mostly in the margins. One of the first maps to show all of Texas, without insets of the Northern or Western portions of the map.
