

Good example of this large format separately issued map of Chesapeake and contigous regions. Extends west to include Lynchburg, VA, Staunton, VA and Somerset, PA. Hand colored by counties. Shows towns, railroads, rivers, lakes, mountains, court houses, landings, ferrys, islands, inlets, and a host of other fine details. A bit toned with some minor scuffing on the paper in a few places, but generally a nice example. Printed by Lang & Cooper. The map is dissected in 30 section and laid on linen, which has been renewed, preserving the original marbled end sheet on the outer most linen fold. In original 16 mo brown cloth covers (rebacked) with gilt embossed title. Yellow pastedown advertisement for Colton's Maps, Atlases & Statistical Wordks, including his Atlas of the World, General Atlas, American Atlas, Cabinet Atlas, Cordova's Texas, Map of the City & County of New York, Guide to Kansas, and several other wonderful rarities.
