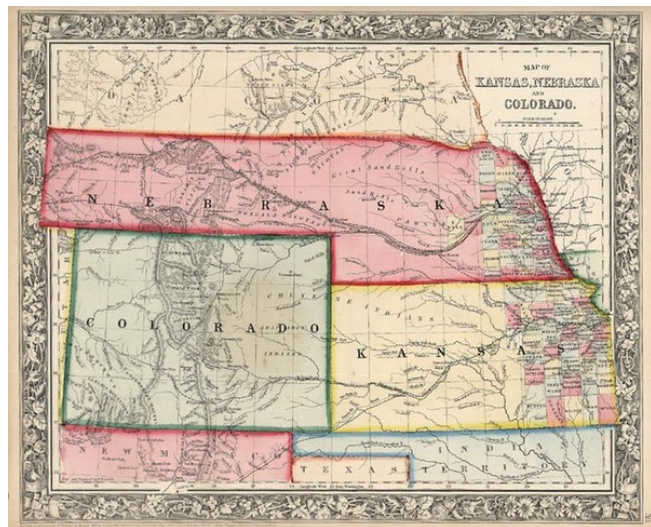

Description:

Excellent early map of the region. Kansas counties cover only the eastern third of the state. Nebraska counties cover only a very small fraction of the state. No counties have yet been delineated in Colorado. The gold regions near Denver City are shown, as are a number of Indian Tribes, early towns, forts, etc. Predates Idaho and Wyoming. The map shows early proposed railroads, forts, Indian tribes, rivers, mountains, etc. The plains region is still very much in transition, with the results of several major explorations commenced immediately after the civil war are not yet in evidence. Decorative floral border. Excellent ephemeral map. Also shows portions of New Mexico, Texas and Indian Territory. A rare early edition, pre-dating the first Colorado Counties.
