Highly detailed regional map of the Washington and British Columbia Coastlines and extending inland to the coast mountain ranges. Cape Lookout, Mount St. Helen and the mouth of the Columbia River are shown in the south, along with Cape Disappointment, Mt. Rainier, and Gray's Harbor. The map is centered on Vancouver Island, and provies a highly detailed treatment of the Straits of Juan De Fuca and the George Gulf and Johnstone Straits, etc. Extends beyond Queen Charlotte's Sound to Cape Swain, etc. The map is one of the sectional maps from the maps in the Atlas to accompany the official report of Vancouver's Voyages. Issued the year after the first edition, the maps provide the first detailed treament of the regions along the NW Coast of America explored by Vancouver, and are an essential item for regional collectors.
