

In addition, Arizona appears below New Mexico and an early ephemeral appearance of Nevada appears, although not including its southern tip and pushed considerably west of its final border with Utah. Nebraska extends to the Rocky Mountains. Kanzas extends to the Rockies. Early explorers notes and routes are shown, including nice details on Conde & Bartlett's line, predating the Gadsden Purchase, Kearny's Route, the Early US Mail Routes, Fremont's Route, Gunnison's Route, Washington Wraps Utah. Strange Dakota configuration. An excellent example of this map.
