## **Description:**

A fine example of this marvelous map of the southwest, one of the few maps to focus on this region during the later part of the 18th Century. Baja California is oddly misprojected and reflects the mission system established by the Jesuits in the 18th Century. The Southwest is dominated by the Rio Grande and the various settlements and missions along the river extending north to Santa Fe and Taos. Texas is named and several interior settlements are shown. Several notes indicate 17th Century explorers tracks, both at land and sea. An excellent example of this striking map.
