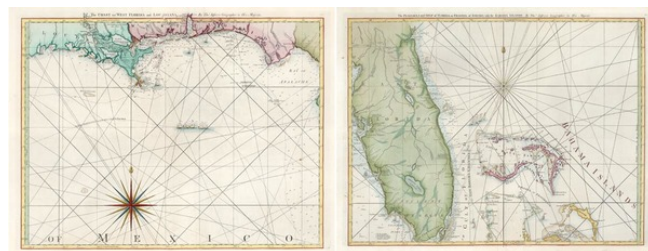

Description:

Striking full color example of the second state of Jefferys map of Florida and the Gulf Coast, from Jeffrey's West India Atlas. The map is the first large format English map to treat the region with such remarkable detail, including soundings and rhumb lines. This second state, issued in the same year as the first state, names the Bay of Spiritu Santo at the mouth of the Mississippi and includes additional placenames not present in the first state. The detail in Florida and the Bahamas is excellent as is the elaborate compass rose and sailing ships. A fine unjoined set of the maps in striking color. While the individual sheets appear periodically on the market, the pair together are now quite rare on the market, especially in full color. Stevens & Tree 26(a).
