St. Joseph is named, an early tribute to Jedidiah Smith. The California Missions are shown. Many Indian Tribes located. Malte-Brun's maps are well regarded for being thoroughly researched and cartographically accurate. This map reflects contemporary Western Cartography immediate before Fremont, Josiah Gregg and other important maps introduced in the 1840s. A few minor candle was spots, else a nice example.
