#### Description:

Scarce pocket map of Upper California, Texas, Mexico and the Southwest, which includes the Spanish Trail, Trader's Route to Independence and several other important western routes. Large inset battlefield of Monterrey, illustrating the Battle during the Mexican War, along with battle annotations. As noted by Wheat, there are several states of this map, this one seemingly the earliest, as it lacks Yerba Buena and several other features. The map was first issued in 1846, Rumsey noting that this is the second issue, the first dated 1847 and predating the inset of Mexico to Vera Cruz. Minor paper restorations and residue of non-archival tape present, but overall a good example in original cloth covers. Rumsey 3119. This edition not in Streeter or Wheat.
