## **Description:**

Decorative combination map and birdseye view, extending from Milton, Pensacola and Ft. Pickens in the southeast to Merminilion Bay, Vermillionville, Alexandria and the course of the Lower Mississippi and Red Rivers in the west. Extends north to Jackson, Vicksburg, Selma, Montgomery and Macon. Centered on Fort Wood, New Orelans, Fort Jackson, Mobile and Pascagoula. Shows towns, forts, roads, railroads, rivers, lakes, islands, harbors, etc. Numberous sailing ships and other embellishments). One tear at the bottom just extending into the water, expertly repaired on the verso. One of six views (the others being Texas, Florida, Carolinas, Kentucky & Tenessee, and the Cheapeake regions) issued in a series by Bachmann and also issued separately (as is the case with the present view, which is unfolded. While the Bachmann view of the Chesapeake region appears on the market with some frequency, this is the first time we have seen we have ever seen the Gulf Coast view.
