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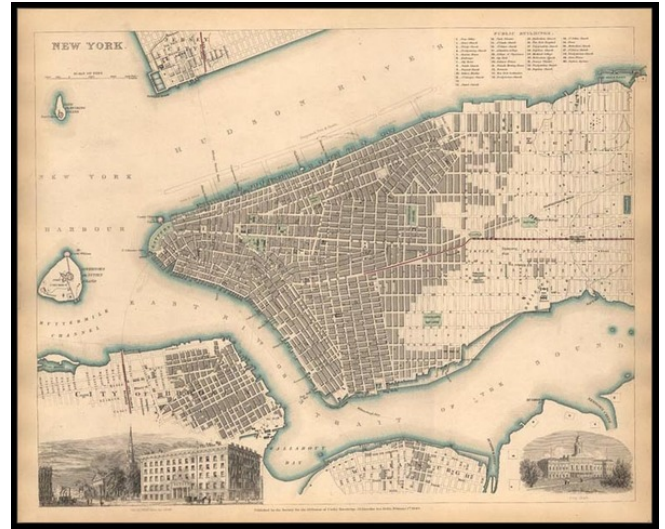

One of the most sought after of all mid-19th Century New York City maps. Extends North to around 40th Street and includes parts of Brooklyn, Williamburgh, Jersey City and Governor's Island. The Harlem Railroad is shown extending into the Bowery, as are the Albany, L Long Island, New York and Williamburgh Ferries. The Proposed Pier & Basin is shown in the Hudson River, as are the ship yards, dry docks and other features in the East River. Large vignette of City Hall and Broadway from the Park. 40 public buildings are named in the key to the map.
