

Rare miniature map of the Middle Colonies, extending to the confluence of the Ohio and Mississippi Rivers and Lake Michigan, from John Gibson's Atlas Minimus, the first miniature English Atlas to include a number or regional maps of the Colonies. While the focal point of the map is the Chesapeake and Delaware Bay regions, the extension of Virginia to the Mississippi and the sparse details in the interior are of note. Nice description of the Pennsylania, Virginia and Delaware in the annotation. A terrific American Miniature, which rarely appears on the market. This is one of the few works to include regional maps of the colonies at the time of the French & Indian War.
