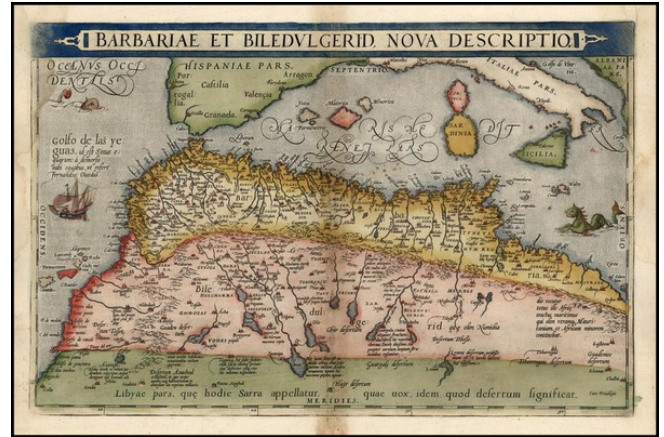

Description:

Nice old color example of Ortelius' map of coastal North Africa and the Mediterranean, from the 1573 Dutch edition of his *Theatrum Orbis Terrarum*, the first modern atlas of the world. The map extends from Morocco and the Sahara to Libya and shown most of the Mediterranean, including the Balearic Islands, Sicily, Corsica, Sardinia and Italy, along the Canaries off the coast of Africa. A nice old color example with wide margins, with minor discoloration at the centerfold, primarily in the lower margin. The map was backed with archival paper in the early 20th Century (easily removed). Van Den Broecke 176.
